#### February 2019

Dear Church Family,

This February is a big month in the life of our denomination. On February 23-26, 2019, a special session of the UMC General Conference will be held in St Louis, gathering delegates from all around the world as they deliberate and vote on our denominational stance on human sexuality. The outcome of this session could result in significant change to the structure of the UMC.

The session will consider three plans for "A Way Forward" to allow the church to deal constructively with differing views on human sexuality within the church while remaining unified as a global church. The Council of Bishops, which commissioned the report containing the proposed plans, is recommending adoption of the "One Church" plan, which would give local congregations and clergy control over whether or not to perform same-sex marriages, and would give annual conferences and their Boards of Ordained Ministry control over whether ordination candidates in committed same-sex relationships can be considered for ordination or allowed to continue to serve in ministry. These proposed plans will be discussed at great length, and most likely amended along the way, so there is no real way to predict what the end result of this Special General Conference Session will be.

We invite you all to stay informed, and please be in prayer for the bishops and delegates that represent us and vote on our behalf. United Methodist News will report from on-site during the conference and update news both **online** and in its **Daily and Weekly Digest e-newsletters**, which we will provide links for through the eBlast. If you have questions, please feel free to contact Pastor Jess, or Carol Rigler, our Lay Delegate to Annual Conference.

On Saturday, March 2<sup>nd</sup> at 10 am, everyone is invited to attend the UMW General Meeting where we will be sharing a presentation on the Special Session of the General Conference, and as best we can, explaining the implications it has for us as a local church. We hope you will join us for this informational session, and feel free to bring any questions you might have.

May God grant us grace and peace in the month ahead.
